A NOTE FROM YOUR FINANCE CHAIR
As we look around and reflect upon all that we are thankful for this Thanksgiving week, I wanted to update our congregation with a few results from Consecration Sunday. A few weeks ago, following an inspiring message by Rev. Dr. Warren Lathem, we gathered in the Family Life Center to enjoy a delicious meal provided at no cost to the church while the Estimate of Giving cards were tallied. Since then, we have received more cards from those unable to attend the luncheon resulting in a total of \$287,259 in estimated general budget giving for 2019. Many of those 65 giving units took the challenge to step up and increase their estimate of giving over the previous year. I am also happy to report that just over \$35,000 has been given this year towards principal debt reduction reducing our mortgage loan balance to \$630,545. All of this is indeed good news! We are so thankful to everyone for their gifts and service to First United Methodist Church of Pine Mountain. Based on this, along with historical giving patterns, the Finance Committee recently approved a budget of \$415,000 for 2019. We look forward to serving God and witnessing for Christ in the coming year as we take the gifts He has so graciously given us and use them to bless others.
